Possibilities for international degree students in Finland

Erasmus+ traineeship grant

Erasmus+ offers a possibility to do your work placement abroad as part of your higher education degree. Erasmus+ traineeship grants are available also for all international degree students. For further information and applying for the grant, please contact the person in charge of international work placements at your home institution.

EDUFI Trainees abroad

International degree students with student visas are not eligible to apply to EDUFI traineeships.

However, you are eligible to apply to EDUFI Trainees Programme if:

- you are a **Finnish citizen** or
- you have a **permanent residence permit** in Finland

and

- you are currently studying **full time** or
- you have **recently graduated** from a higher education institution

However, please notice that fluent Finnish skills are required for most of the EDUFI traineeships abroad. For traineeships at the Finnish embassies abroad you need to have Finnish citizenship. Further information about EDUFI Trainees Programme (in Finnish): www.cimo.fi/harjoittelupaikat
